

KRAJNOVIĆ Dušanka

Dušanka Krajnović, PhD is a full professor at the Faculty of Pharmacy, University of Belgrade, where she graduated, and also gained her Master of Science diploma with a major on History of Pharmaceutical Deontology in Serbia (2000), and completed her PhD with a major on Pharmacy Ethics (2004). Her doctoral thesis was concerned with the development of applied ethics in pharmacy profession and practice, and she addressed the variety of ethical norms and normative from historical perspectives. As a social pharmacy and public health specialist, she holds a chair of public health specialization in the field of Social Pharmacy at the Faculty of Pharmacy, University of Belgrade, and leads the research group of Social Pharmacy and Pharmaceutical Practice. Dr. Krajnović has been involved in teaching the history of pharmacy for pharmacy undergraduates since 2005, and postgraduates since 2007. She was commissioned to develop, design and teach the subject History of Medicine and Pharmacy for PhD students at the University of Belgrade. She was involved in preserving, researching and presenting the pharmaco-historical collection at the Museum for the History of Pharmacy at Faculty of Pharmacy since 2000 and initiated the establishment of Museum Gallery in Faculty hall in 2015, curating several exhibitions there. She made significant contribution in formal re-establishment of the Museum in today's capacity and initiated the introduction of the professional curator for the Museum. She has been researching and writing about the history of pharmacy for over 25 years, and her output has included 2 books and several chapters in edited volumes, and over 50 articles in peer-reviewed journals. Dr. Krajnović is member of editorial board in 4 scientific journals.

Dr. Krajnović is a member of reputable associations, such as the FIP, Pharmaceutical Association of Serbia and the International Society for the History of Pharmacy, of which she has been serving as General Secretary from 2014 onwards. She was elected as member of the International Academy of the History of Pharmacy in 2007. Dr. Krajnović was awarded the silver medal 'Prof. Dr. Alexandru Ionescu-Matiu' by the Romanian Society for the History of Pharmacy, in October 2022, making her an honorary member of this society. She has participated as a researcher / consultant / coordinator / board member in a number of national and international projects.
